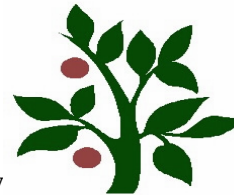

ORGANIC & FAIR TRADE COFFEE

We have added to our already plentiful coffee choices with two new organic coffees. Organic coffees are cultivated with natural gardening techniques, like composting and terracing, and are grown entirely without pesticides, herbicides, or chemical fertilizers. Sumatra Takengen is grown in the scenic highland slopes of the Gayo mountains in the Lake Takengen region of Northern Sumatra. It's cup is full bodied, slightly fruity, and clean with a sweet finish. Ethiopian Yirgacheffe is grown in the Addis Ababa region of Ethiopia. It is well balanced with a nice body, and bright snappy acidity



In addition to being organic, this coffee is Fair Trade. Fair Trade coffee guarantees a minimum price paid to the farmers who grow and harvest the bean. This ensures they receive a fair price for their efforts and enables them to care for themselves, and their communities, while reinvesting in the care and quality
